 - a. Cypress Place Park;

 - a. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Plantation Lakes, Section 23;
 - b. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Westfield Ranch, Section 1;
 - c. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Westfield Ranch, Section 2;

- d. water, sewer, and drainage facilities to serve Westfield Ranch, Section 3;
- e. lift station to serve Westfield Ranch;
- f. wastewater treatment plant expansion;
- g. water plant no. 2 and water well no. 3;
- h. water plant no. 1 and water well no. 1 improvements;
- i. fence for contract deputy building and adjacent District facilities and sidewalk;
- j. driveway modifications at District facilities;
- k. drainage issues in area adjacent to Northwest Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 12;

- q. utility availability letters.

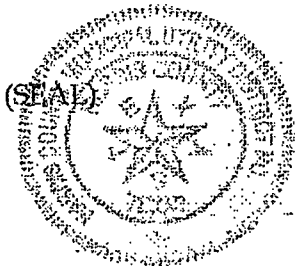
14. Operation of District facilities, billings, and repairs and maintenance, including the following:
