 - iii. approve pay estimate, change order, and final acceptance for construction of 8" water line;
 - b. Durham Park detention pond maintenance matters;
 - c. District park and recreational improvements;
 - d. deeds, easements, conveyances, and maintenance agreements; and
 - e. update on bond application no. 4, and adopt Resolution Authorizing Application to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for Approval of Project and Bonds.
5. Report regarding development within the District, including status of home sales, apartment development and commercial projects.
6. Discussion and action relating to the addition of law enforcement/patrol services to the District and its facilities.
