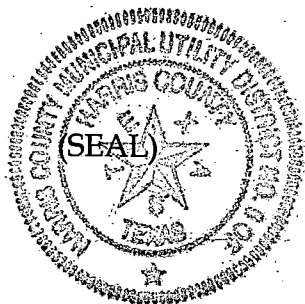


NOTICE OF MEETING

HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 6 OF HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS

The Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 6 will hold a regular meeting on **Tuesday, April 18, 2017**, at 6:00 p.m. at the Water Plant Site, 7830 Round Bank, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. Minutes.
3. Agreement with Westbank Homeowners Association for Security Services.
4. Discuss garbage collection matters.
5. Tax assessment and collections matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of bills.
6. Discuss Out-of-District Service Agreement with EWC Fairbanks North Houston, LP.
7. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
8. Authorize renewal of District's insurance policies, including review of engineer's list of District facilities to be insured.
9. Operation of District facilities, billings, repairs, and maintenance.
10. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
11. Conduct annual review and receive report from operator on Identity Theft Prevention Program and adopt Identity Theft Prevention Program Amendment.
12. Amend Rate Order.
13. Engineering matters, including:
 - a. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance and direct engineer to notify insurance company of new facility for the following:
 - i. wastewater treatment plant rehabilitation;
 - ii. lift station at the wastewater treatment plant; and
 - iii. 2016 sanitary sewer rehabilitation, phase VII.
