

9. Such other matters as may come before the Board.

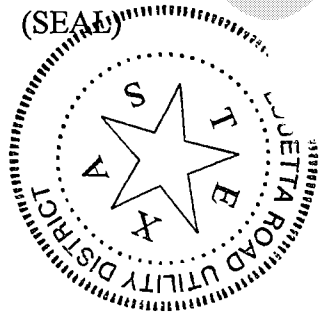
