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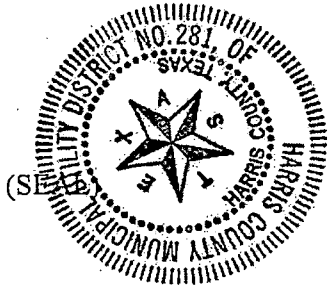

NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING


Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above-captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District. The meeting will be held on Monday, February 6, 2023, at 11:00 a.m. The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Approval of minutes of the January 9, 2023, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Review and approve continuing disclosure report;
4. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Consider solicitation of proposals from tax assessor-collectors;
7. Report and legal action taken by the District's Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney;
8. Adoption of Resolution Concerning Developed District Status for 2023 Tax Year;
9. Operator's report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - (b) Appeals of District charges;
 - (c) Compliance with permit and regulatory requirements;
 - (d) Report relative to water accountability in the District, including discussion regarding issues with Mueller Systems, LLC's ("Mueller") meters; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith;
 - (e) Status of purchase and installation of new meters;
 - (f) Status of repairs to sanitary sewer manholes; and
 - (g) Review of cost estimate related to modification or replacement of valves;
10. Engineer's report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, and approving of related storm water plans;
 - (b) Authorizing the award of or concurrence in award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, authorizing acceptance of TEC Form 1295, and approval of any related storm water permits;
 - (c) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the

- approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders and authorize acceptance of TEC Form 1295;
- (d) Acceptance and/or conveyance of sites or easements for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;
 - (e) Status of storm water quality permits;
 - (f) Discussion of five-year Capital Improvement Plan; and
 - (g) Status of expansion of Northpointe Boulevard by Harris County; authorize any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith;
11. Status of annexation of 8.1938 acre tract into the boundaries of the District; receive and act upon Petition for Addition of Land to the District, including the adoption of an Order Adding Land and Redefining the Boundaries of the District and approval and execution of Amended and Restated District Information Form;
 12. Review of annual survey of wage rate scales and consider adoption of Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Projects;
 13. Developer's Report;
 14. Issuance of utility commitments;
 15. Monthly activity reports received from the Harris County Constable's office and the Harris County Sheriff's office;
 16. Review and approval of proposals relative to renewal of the District's general liability, umbrella liability, property, boiler and machinery, director and officer liability, and pollution liability insurance coverage for policies expiring March 31, 2023;
 17. Attorney's Report;
 18. Discussion regarding claims against Mueller; status of response from Mueller in connection with District's lawsuit;
 19. Convene in executive session for consultation with attorney pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Section 551.071 and/or Section 551.072, Texas Government Code;
 20. Reconvene in open session and authorize any necessary action resulting from executive session; and
 21. Consideration of matters for possible placement on future agendas.


