Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting via telephone conference call pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.125, as amended, and as modified by the temporary suspension of various provisions thereof effective March 16, 2020, by the Governor of Texas in accordance with the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, all as related to the Governor's proclamation on March 13, 2020, certifying that the COVID-19 pandemic poses an imminent threat of disaster and declaring a state of disaster for all counties in Texas. The meeting will be held on Monday, July 26, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Call to order, including explanation of telephone conference call meeting procedures;
- 2. Public comments;
- 3. Review and approve the minutes of the June 28, 2021, Board of Directors meeting;
- 4. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports;
- 5. Adoption of Order Selecting Depository,
- 6. Status of audit report for fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (filing deadline November 12, 2021;)
- 7. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented, approving moving of accounts to uncollectible roll, status of collection of delinquent taxes and authorizing lawsuit and/or foreclosure, as appropriate;

 - (b) Authorizing the award of construction contracts or concurrence of award of contracts for the construction and/or maintenance of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits;
 - (c) Status of construction and/or repair of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any change orders;
 - (i) Status of contract with Texas Pride Utilities, Inc. for Phase II rehabilitation of the District's Sanitary Sewer Collection System;
 - (d) Acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes;

 - (a) Request for increased capacity allocation to serve approximately 27 acre tract; review of capacity analysis prepared by Sander Engineering Corporation;
- 16. Developer's Report, including the approval of Utility Development Agreements and/or Waiver Agreements and the concurrence in the award of contracts and/or payments in connection with the construction of utility facilities to serve land within the District;
- 17. Status of District's security patrol contract with the Harris County Constable's Office and security issues within the District;
