Harris County Clerk's Office Preparing for Potential Closures Due to Dangerous Winter Weather Conditions

(Houston, TX) – Harris County Clerk Teneshia Hudspeth is preparing her office in advance of the winter weather expected to impact the region in the coming days. The Harris County Clerk's Office (HCCO) will follow recommendations from state and local officials. This includes the potential closure of HCCO offices and voting centers currently operating for the Congressional District 18 Special Runoff Election.

"The safety of the public, election workers, and our employees is our top priority as we monitor the rapidly changing weather conditions," **said Clerk Hudspeth**. "If closures or delays become necessary, we will notify the public immediately."

Meteorologists predict that a powerful cold front will begin affecting the region Saturday evening and continue into early next week. Freezing rain or sleet is possible during this time.

"Our team is actively assessing conditions and coordinating with the Texas Secretary of State and emergency management officials. Any operational changes will be made as early as possible to minimize disruption," **added Clerk Hudspeth**. "I strongly encourage voters registered in CD-18 to vote today through Saturday."
