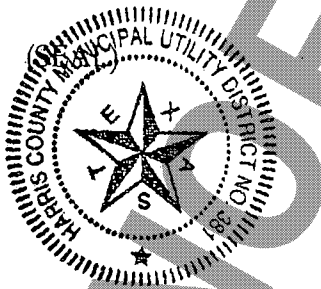

NOTICE OF MEETING


HARRIS COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 381
