
The meeting will be held on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at 11:00 A.M.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Public comments;
- 2. Review and approval of the minutes of the Board of Directors meeting held February 22, 2023;
- 3. Status of filing of Annual Continuing Disclosure Report; authorize any action in connection therewith (due February 28, 2023);
- 4. Tax Assessor/Collector's Report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
- 5. Report and legal action taken by the District's Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney, authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim and approval of turn-offs; status of water terminations related thereto;
- 6. Bookkeeper's Report, including financial and investment reports and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
