NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING**

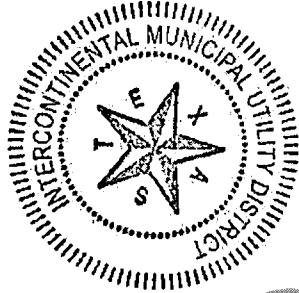
Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77056, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Friday, February 14, 2025, at 12:00 noon.


The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public Comments;
2. Approval of the minutes of the January 10, 2025, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Bookkeepers Report;
4. Tax Assessor-Collector report;
5. Developer's Report, including approval and execution of utility development agreements with developers relative to property within the District;
6. Engineer's Report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design and/or advertisement for bids for the construction of facilities within the District, authorizing acceptance of TEC Form 1295, and approving of related storm water plans;
 - (b) Authorizing the award of or concurrence in award of contracts for the construction of facilities within the District, and approval of any related storm water permits;
 - (i) Water, Sewer, and Drainage Facilities to serve Townsen Landing, Section 1B; and
 - (ii) Townsen Mitigation Basin No. 2 Expansion;
 - (c) Status of construction of facilities to serve land within the District, including the approval of any pay estimates and/or change orders;
 - (i) Water, Sewer, and Drainage Facilities to serve Harmony Cove, Section 1 (Blazey Construction Services, LLC); and
 - (ii) Harmony Cove Lift Station (Persons Services Corp);
 - (d) Acceptance and/or conveyance of sites or easements for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, and acceptance of facilities, and conveyance of utilities to the City of Humble for ownership, operation and maintenance purposes;
7. Adoption of Resolution Concerning Developed District Status for 2025 Tax Year;

8. Review of annual survey of wage rate scales and consider adoption of Resolution Adopting Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Projects;
9. Storm Water Management Program Report;
10. Review and approval of proposals relative to renewal of the District's general liability, umbrella liability, property, boiler and machinery, director and officer liability, and pollution liability insurance coverage for policies expiring March 31, 2025;
