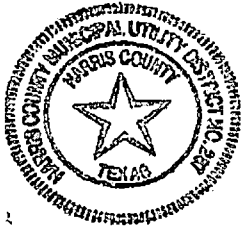

4. Resolution Regarding Development Status for 2024 Tax Year.
5. Discuss Association of Water Board Directors summer conference, authorize reimbursement of eligible expenses, and authorize attendance at winter conference.
6. Financial and bookkeeping matters, including payment of the bills and review of investments.
7. Approve audit for fiscal year end March 31, 2024.
8. Operation of District facilities, including billing, repairs, maintenance, customer inquiries, and customer communications.
9. Hearing on termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers and authorize termination of service.
10. Mowing and detention facilities maintenance report, inspections, repairs, permits, status of storm water quality permits, and lake maintenance, including any related agreements, amendments, proposals, and budgets.
11. Engineering matters, including:
  - a. authorize design of District facilities;
  - b. approve plans and specifications and authorize advertisement for bids of District facilities;
  - c. review bids, award contract(s), and approve letter financing agreements for District facilities;
  - d. approve pay estimates, change orders, and final acceptance as appropriate for construction of District projects;
    - i. wastewater treatment plant drum screen addition;
    - ii. Waterstone West Public Utilities Phase II (Prime);
  - e. deeds, easements and abandonment of easements, consents to encroachment, facility conveyances, appraisals, requests for service and utility commitment letters, and Phase I Environmental Site Assessment proposals;

  - i. EPA Lead and Copper Rule Revisions, including related compliance matters.

  - b. surveying and obtaining required authorizations for District projects or facilities, including status of and approvals regarding same;

    - i. Waterstone drainage channel trail and pedestrian bridge; and
  - g. participation in joint Morton Ranch trail and pedestrian bridge project, including related application(s) to Harris County Precinct No. 4, letter(s) of support, funding, and agreement(s).
13. Report regarding development in the District, including:
- a. residential and commercial development; and
  - b. potential new developers, including approval of development financing agreement(s), utility commitment letter(s), and/or related documents and agreements for the same.
14. Security services matters, including Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with Harris County.
15. West Harris County Regional Water Authority matters.
16. District correspondence, including correspondence by District and correspondence received by District, directors, or consultants.

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17. Convene in executive session to consult with attorney pursuant to Section 551.071, Texas Government Code, to seek the advice of attorney regarding pending or contemplated litigation or to seek and receive legal advice by the District's attorney.
18. Reconvene in open session and authorize appropriate action regarding pending or contemplated litigation or the legal advice by the District's attorney.
