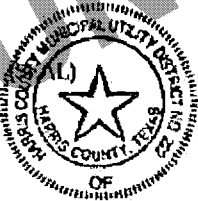

12. Review Contract for Acquisition, Construction, Financing and Operation of Wastewater Treatment Facilities, and authorize appropriate action if necessary.
13. Matters relating to North Harris County Regional Water Authority, including pumpage fees, surface water conversion program and issuance of bonds.
14. Attorney's report.
