NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

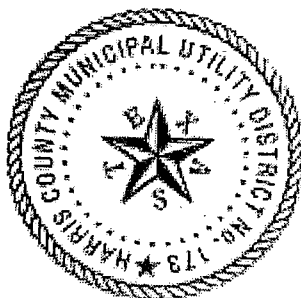
