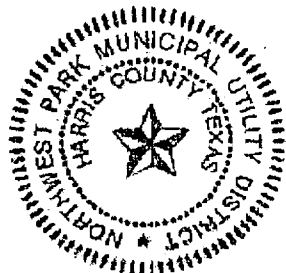
NORTHWEST PARK MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING
