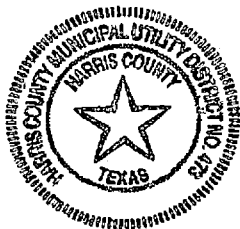
NOTICE OF MEETING

 - ii. storm outfall improvements; and
 - b. accept and convey deeds and easements and related Phase I environmental assessment proposals, consents to encroachment, maintenance letters, requests for service, or utility commitment letters, letters of no objection.
8. Ratification of the First Amendment to Amended and Restated Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for Gateway Ten Business Park.
9. Report on detention pond maintenance and mowing, including maintenance budget and proposals for work.
10. Discuss meeting schedule.
