NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 1300 Post Oak Boulevard, Suite 2500, Houston, Harris County, Texas, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Wednesday, October 5, 2022, at 12:00 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

- 1. Public comments;
- 2. Approve the minutes of the September 7, 2022, Board of Directors meeting;
- 3. Conduct a public hearing regarding the adoption of the District's 2022 tax rate;
- 4. Levy of the District's 2022 debt service and maintenance tax rates, and the adoption of an Order in connection therewith;
- 5. Approval and execution of an Amended District Information Form;
- 6. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including authorize payment of invoices presented, approving moving of accounts to uncollectible roll, status of collection of delinquent taxes, including authorizing lawsuit and/or foreclosure, as appropriate;
- 7. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2022 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:
 - a. the required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
 - b. the means of providing such notice;
- 8. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, and take any action in connection therewith, including authorizing foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, and the filing of proofs of claim;
- 9. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports, and the authorization of the payment of invoices presented;
- 10. Report by Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc. regarding maintenance of detention and drainage facilities; proposals and any related Texas Ethics Commission ("TEC") Form 1295s;
