And to set the dates and times for the following meetings so the public can provide input on each of these two proposed sets of tax rates: A Public Hearing on September 21, 2021 at 1 PM for discussion of the proposed rates for Harris County, the Harris County Flood Control District, the Harris County Hospital District, and the Port of Houston Authority of Harris County, and a meeting to adopt rates for all taxing units on September 28, 2021 at 10 A.M., and there would be an understanding that the under Commissioner Cagle's proposal that the Maintenance and Operations amount would also go to Debt Service.
