32	269	Public Hearings	<p>That Commissioners Court adopts the Short Fiscal Year 2022 Proposed Budget for Harris County, the Harris County Flood Control District and the Harris County Toll Authority as presented by County Administrator Dave Berry;</p> <p>Commissioners Court approves the 2023 Planning Budget for Harris County as presented by County Administrator Dave Berry;</p> <p>The Office of County Administration and other relevant departments are directed to capitalize CIP-related labor costs where legal and appropriate and transfer the corresponding labor costs appropriations to the General Fund;</p> <p>Harris County shall allocate the General Funds recovered from labor capitalization to increase the hourly wage rate for law enforcement personnel;</p> <p>Harris County shall adjust the adopted General Fund budget for the Engineering Department to capitalize \$4.1 million of labor in Short Fiscal Year 2022 and \$7 million in Fiscal Year 2023;</p> <p>Harris County shall allocate the freed-up General Funds to support a 3% raise for all Harris County Sheriff and Constable deputies.</p> <p>The Office of County Administration shall conduct a thorough review of all qualifying departments to determine if additional capitalizable labor costs can be identified to extend a 3% raise to all ranks of law enforcement;</p> <p>The Office of County Administration shall conduct a salary analysis of law enforcement in the Harris County region and all applicable County employees whose base pay for their positions is less than One-Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000);</p> <p>The Office of County Administration shall develop a four-year plan that will bring pay parity to all County employees whose base pay for their positions is less than One-Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000);</p> <p>*****</p> <p>That the County Administrator shall conduct a study to identify the potential cost impacts and savings of service consolidation in the management and administration of County park, community center, road and bridge, and fleet operations;</p> <p>After the County Administrator provides this analysis, County Commissioners Court may consider how best to prioritize those cost savings to invest in services that directly address the reduction, prevention, and root causes of violence in Harris County;</p>
